

Pacifica Housing is a non-profit charitable organization, incorporated in 1988. We provide affordable housing for low income families and people with disabilities as well as supported housing for people who are chronically homeless and those at risk of becoming homeless. Pacifica Housing Services further provides advocacy and referral services for those who need it.

Pacifica Housing – Affordable Homes **30 Complexes / 776 units on Vancouver Island**

Family & Accessible Housing

- The family housing portfolio consists of twenty-six buildings (640 units) of affordable, accessible housing for low income families and persons with disabilities. It includes *The Georgian* (5 units for “empty nesters” at risk of homelessness) and *The Wing* (market housing and housing for moderate income families and adults).

Supported Housing

- The supported housing portfolio consists of four buildings (Camas Gardens, Clover Place, Medewiwin and Waterview) with a total of 136 units for people who are chronically homeless and living with mental health and/or addictions issues.

Pacifica Housing Services

- Housing outreach and support services are provided to individuals who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Housing is secured through partnerships and relationships with private landlords and supported housing sites. Staff work with clients to address mental illnesses and/or addiction issues and to foster independence and life skills.

Pacifica Housing – Programs **Better Lives**

The Community Meal Program: monthly communal meals at Pacifica's supported housing complexes ensure a nutritious meal for all, build community within the complex and provide opportunities to exercise life skills such as meal planning, preparation and cleanup.

The Peer Support Work Program: The program fosters a sense of pride in home & surroundings; develops and strengthens life skills, encourages social interaction and promotes vocational skills in preparation for the mainstream labor force. Tenants are remunerated weekly with grocery vouchers. Additional program funds are always needed for: first aid/ WHMIS training, work clothes, and grocery vouchers.

The Community Virtues Initiative: Based on the internationally renowned Virtues Project™, initiatives such as Community Garden Projects and weekly Youth Groups promote the vision of “a vibrant community of empowered individuals and families capable of making and maintaining safe and healthy lifestyle choices that maximize their individual and collective potential.”
